



Special Event Fee Schedule

Arch Pavilion	\$75 per hour \$500 daily rate	\$150 per hour \$900 daily rate

Marble Hall Lawn Tent Surcharge \$500

Multi-Day Rate for weddings and large parties at Marble Hall, Pavillion and Lawn \$5,000

TVA Pavilion	\$100 per hour/\$600 daily rate
Hecht Pavilion, Riverview & and Lakeshore Shelters	\$50 per hour/\$300 daily rate <i>Hourly usage requires a two-hour minimum.</i>

LAWNS

Main Events Lawn	\$1,500 per day
West Terrace, Hilltop Meadow, Waterside Meadow, East Terrace	\$300 per day
River Terrace	\$500 per day

A surcharge of \$500 will apply to lawn events that include a tent larger than 25 x 25. There will be a limit on the number of tented events held each year.

Trail

Trail cannot be closed for private events

Hank Rappé Playground

The playground cannot be reserved for special events. Tables at the playground are available on a first come-first served basis. The adjacent TVA Pavilion can be reserved.

Baseball Fields

The upper and lower baseball fields can be reserved in the off-season for games or special events.

Important details:

- Scheduled use of all facilities is subject to availability, insurance requirements, and execution of a Facilities Use Agreement.
- The rates listed are indicative only and do not constitute an offer. Rates are subject to change without notice prior to execution of a Facilities Use Agreement.
- Security/Damage Deposit required for pavilions, shelters, and events with 50 people or more.
- Security personnel required for events with more than 100 people.
- Extra charges apply if cleaning is required after the event and if the canvas panels at Marble Hall are lowered for an event.
- Special rules are applicable to service of alcohol at events. No use of alcohol is permitted without an executed Facilities Use Agreement and Alcohol Rider.
